How it works.

If you qualify for the program an Energy Advisor will conduct a free home-energy assessment to determine what upgrades will help your home. This can include insulation, water heater wraps, lighting, programmable thermostats and more.

One of our professional contractors will manage the installation of all upgrades.

The Low Income Qualification cut-offs are based on Low Income Cut-offs (LICOs) pre-tax figures set by Statistics Canada. Dollar figures are maximum allowable household earnings before taxes.
