Efficiency Nova Scotia is offering qualified people who participate in the EnerGuide for Houses program:

- A \$150 plus HST rebate to cover the cost of an EnerGuide for Houses “D” and “E” evaluation.

After completing the energy upgrades to your home, you may also be eligible for:

- Valuable rebates for making heating and building envelope upgrades, based on the outcome of the “E” evaluation and the upgrades you make.
- An additional grant of \$400 – provided you qualify for at least \$200 in “building envelope” rebates, as outlined in the EnerGuide Rebate Guide.

To be reimbursed for the cost of the EnerGuide assessment, complete this application and attach your EnerGuide assessment receipt and proof of income. You will automatically be eligible for the rebates outlined in the EnerGuide Rebate Guide plus an additional \$400 grant if you qualify. To qualify for the low-to-modest income program, income and program criteria must be met.
