



**Nova Scotia EnerGuide for Houses  
Assistance Program for Low- to Modest-Income Nova Scotians**

Conserve Nova Scotia is offering qualified people who participate in the Nova Scotia EnerGuide for Houses program the following:

- A \$150 plus HST rebate to cover the cost of an EnerGuide for Houses "A" and "B" evaluation
- An energy savings kit that can reduce household energy use by up to \$100 per year

After completing energy upgrades to your home, you may also be eligible for:

- A grant of up to \$6,500 in provincial and federal rebates based on the outcome of the "B" evaluation and the upgrades you make
- An additional provincial government grant of \$400.

To be reimbursed the \$150 (plus HST) cost of the EnerGuide audit, complete this application form and attach your EnerGuide audit receipt. You will automatically be eligible for the provincial grant (up to a maximum of \$1,500) and the federal grant (up to a maximum of \$5,000) plus an additional \$400 provincial grant when you qualify. To qualify for the low- to modest-income program, income and program criteria must be met and the follow up or "B" EnerGuide evaluation must have been completed after October 12, 2005.
