

# Barricade™

Modular Subfloor Panel  
by OvrX



## Installation

### Step 1

After clearing floor space, check floor for imperfections. If there are imperfections greater than 1/4", we recommend that you use a self-leveling compound to fix them. Once this is done, lay down spacer boards in your starting corner to provide a minimum 1/2" expansion gap around the perimeter of the floor.

### Step 2

Align the first panel with the two groove sides against the spacer boards. Add additional panels in one direction until you cannot fit a panel in. Measure the remaining space and cut tile appropriately.



### Step 3

Stagger the second row so that the seams are off-set. Level your floor as you go using our OvrX Shim Kit. Just slide a pad under the portion of the tile that is raised to eliminate excessive sagging.

If your floor has a slight slant the stiffness of Barricade Subfloor may eliminate the need for leveling. Test your floor as you go by walking on the panels to find uneven spots that require leveling.

**\*\* NOTE \*\*** If you are installing carpet, do not glue directly onto Barricade subfloor panels.



#### Tools Required:

- Hammer and tapping block
- Circular saw or jigsaw
- Tape measure
- Carpenter's pencil
- Carpenter's square
- Pull bar
- 1/2" Spacer Boards
- OvrX Shim Kit

-OvrX tiles must be used in strict conformity with its intended and expressly recommended use.

This warranty only applies to the original purchaser and installation site and is not transferable.

Any claim under the 25 year limited warranty shall be made by contacting your local retailer or OvrX Manufacturing Inc. directly. Proof of purchase including date of purchase must be presented to make a claim.
